- File name should meet the user name in Latin (for example: Ivanov_Ivan).

- The file sending is available by CD-ROM or by electronic mail (e-mail subject must contain the name and the surname of the participant and indication "for the conference").

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MATERIALS

Volume – up to 3 pages, word processor – Microsoft Word, page format – A4 (297x210 mm), margins – 20 mm, Font – Times New Roman, Font size – 14, line spacing – 1, style – Normal.

- The first paragraph – full name.
 - The second paragraph – position, place of work (study), scientific degree, academic rank.
 - The third paragraph – title of the report.
- Next – the text of report is placed with 1 cm paragraph indent.
- List of references (if available) is placed at the end of the text. It should be written in accordance with bibliography standards.
